- Max Vehicle Height: 13 1/2ft
- Max Vehicle Width: 8 1/2ft
- Combined Length: 75ft
- Max Trailer Length: 45ft
- Max Trailer Width: 8ft-6in
- Max Trailer Height: 13ft-6in
- Motor Home Length: 45ft
- Two Vehicle Max Length: 75ft
- Triple Tow Allowed: Yes. With certain qualifications. Only with fifth-wheel trailer in Arizona, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, Manitoba (maximum length 23m) and Saskatchewan

- Safety Chains Required: Yes
- Breakaway Required: Yes. Required on trailers over 6000lbs
- Fire Extinguisher: Not Stated
- Flares & Signs: Yes
- Trailer Brakes Required: Yes. Required if gross weight is over 3000lbs
- Towed Cars: Brake hook-up required except where brakes on towing vehicle are adequate to stop both vehicles within distance required by law

- Wipers: Yes
- Max Tow Speed: 70mph
- Ride in 5th Wheel: Yes
- Ride Pickup Camper: Yes
- Ride Travel Trailer: Yes
- Weight Limits for Towing without Auxiliary Brakes: Required if gross weight is over 3000lbs
- Maximum Length - RV & Trailer Combo: 60ft. In a recreation vehicle combination consisting of a pickup truck, a camper-trailer and a boat, flat bed, horse trailer, etc. the camper-trailer cannot exceed 28ft in length, and the entire combination cannot exceed 60ft in length. The combination cannot be operated in the seven country Metro area from 6am to 9am and 4pm to 7pm Mon - Fri
